<b>Who can be a part of CCIP?</b>	A person who has a Family Child Care (FCC) license, works in a licensed FCC, and/or is planning to get a FCC license or wants to expand a FCC license	
<b>What is CCIP training based on?</b>	5 CCIP Training Modules	12 CA ECE Competencies
<b>What does it take to become a CCIP Trainee?</b>	25 hours of training, with 5 hours in each of the 5 Modules	Completion of a Self-Reflection Survey & 25 hours of training in the CA ECE Competencies

### What do these changes mean for CCIP training participants?

- Starting July 1, 2017, you need to create a **FREE** California Early Care and Education Workforce Registry account. Joining the Registry means that you can:
  - track training that you complete whether it is provided by CCIP or another quality contractor
  - access a statewide training calendar
  - use the Resume Builder and Job Board
