Statewide Waivers for Licensing Requirements due to COVID-19 [PIN 20-04](#)

Social and Physical Distancing Guidance (capacity and ratios) [PIN 20-06-CCP](#):

For family child care homes, if a small is utilizing the "Blanket Waiver," their capacity is the same as a large (14, with a helper of course). Nevertheless, group size may not exceed 10 children. If infants are involved (age redefined during this State of Emergency to 0-18mo), then the ratio is either 1:4 (all infants) or 1:6 (max 2 infants).

Tele-Inspections [PIN 20-08-CCP](#): Beginning March 26, 2020 Licensing Program Analysts (LPAs) will conduct tele-inspections as part of Community Care Licensing Division's (CCLD) emergency response to the spread of Coronavirus Disease 2019.
