This 4-part series meets the 8 hour qualifications of the health and safety codes required to become a licensed childcare provider in California. In order to receive a childcare license, at least one director or teacher at each childcare facility must have a total of 16 hours of health and safety training. This includes 8 hours of CPR and First Aid and 8 hours of Preventative Health and Safety training.



Preventative health focuses on the recognition, management, and prevention of infectious diseases, injury prevention, emergency preparedness, sanitary food handling, and nutrition. As a childcare provider you have an important role in the development of our children and can significantly impact their long term health.
