Children are one of the most important investments we can make in our future. When families encounter financial hardships, children suffer the most. As a community, we can help shape a child's life dramatically and make a positive impact on their future and our future.


The Community Chest Fund was created in 1993 as an avenue to make that possible.

Because of people like you, the Community Chest Fund works! Below are a few examples of how families have benefited from the generous donations received from giving community members:

 **Medical . . .** Child care costs were covered for two mothers being treated for cancer. Another family received gas money so they could take their sick child to see a specialist in Sacramento. Donations also go to help pay for eyeglasses, medications or health- and dental-related services not covered by insurance. Contributions also go to help pay for physical, emotional or self-esteem needs of children.

 **Victims of Domestic Violence . . .** Siblings were treated to Camp so their mother could leave a dangerous family situation. Groceries were provided to a homeless, pregnant mother after she left her violent partner. A young girl was afforded two weeks of needed counseling.

 **Child Enrichment . . .** Children were able to attend water safety classes and swimming lessons, summer camps and performing arts classes. Several others learned a sport or how to play a musical instrument. A child with special needs was able to take lessons and learned to ski.

 **Other . . .** A disabled mother received emergency rent assistance. A single mother in need received diapers and formula for her child. Two young boys were given school clothes and supplies. A needy family received a new refrigerator.

The scope of worthwhile aid that can be given to children in need throughout Sierra and Nevada Counties is endless and depends solely on the commitment of our community.
